

Assessment Scheduling Details

The ANet interim assessment is administered 4 times a year in two subjects (Math and English Language Arts).

Schools administering one subject will schedule 4 assessment dates.

Schools administering two subjects will schedule between 4 and 8 assessment days.

When scheduling your test dates with the Achievement Network please consider the following:

- Are you testing one subject per day or both subjects on one day?
- How much time do you have to give to testing each subject (we recommend approx. 90 minutes)?
- Does the logistic lead have enough time to send back the answer sheets at the end of each testing day?
- Is there a minimum of 72 hours (3 business days) between the test date and the data meeting?

School year calendars and break will vary from school to school. When scheduling your test administration dates, please check your school calendar to ensure that there are no conflicts.

Please note if you are testing in the days surrounding a National Holiday as it may impact the data turnaround time.

ANet recognizes the following National Holidays:
